II. Purpose and Scope

The primary purpose of the listserv is to:

- Share relevant information, updates, and news related to nature and human health
- > Exchange resources, such as articles, reports, and research findings
- Promote events, workshops, seminars, and conferences happening in the community related to nature and human health
- Facilitate the sharing of job postings, internships, and other professional opportunities related to nature and health
- > Foster respectful and constructive discussions on relevant topics

III. Guidelines

- Respectful Communication
 - Treat all listserv members with respect, even in disagreement.
 - Refrain from using offensive, discriminatory, or derogatory language.
 - Avoid personal attacks or harassment in any form.
 - Maintain a professional and courteous tone in all communications.
- Relevant Content
 - All content shared on the listserv should be relevant to the NHH-UT's mission (To articulate and foster critical links between nature and human health by providing a collaborative arena in which representatives of diverse societal sectors can equitably engage, share ideas, formulate actions, and implement solutions.).
 - Avoid sharing spam, advertisements, or unrelated content.
 - Messages promoting the sale of products and services will not be allowed.
 - Verify the accuracy of information before sharing to avoid misinformation.
 - Evidence-based policy recommendations are allowed but avoid any political campaigning or political commentary.
- Sharing Resources and Events
 - When sharing resources, include a brief description and the source/link.
 - Clearly label any event announcements with relevant details such as date, time, location, and registration information.

- Job Postings and Opportunities
 - Share job postings, internships, and other professional opportunities that are relevant to the realm of nature and health.
 - Include comprehensive information about the role, requirements, application process, and contact details.
- Discussion Etiquette
 - Engage in discussions with a focus on providing insights, asking questions, and sharing knowledge.
 - Stay on-topic and avoid derailing discussions with unrelated content.
 - Use subject lines that accurately reflect the content of your message.
- Confidentiality
 - Respect the privacy of listserv members and avoid sharing sensitive or confidential information without proper authorization.

The listserv has designated moderators who will ensure that the guidelines are followed and the discussions remain productive. Moderators have the authority to remove or edit content that violates the guidelines.
